Fort Boise Produce, located on the Idaho-Eastern Oregon border ([Map](#)), packages and ships fresh onions. Fort Boise Produce onions are shipped by truck from our Parma, Idaho location and by railcar from our Nyssa, Oregon facilities to locations across the United States, Canada, and Mexico. We take special precautions in procuring refrigerated and ventilated compartments designed to deliver quality onions to our customers.

Fort Boise Produce's truck loading facility is located at milepost #1 on Hwy 20/26 in Idaho, between Nyssa, Oregon and Highway 95 in Idaho. Loading hours at Fort Boise Produce are from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Saturday. Trucks are loaded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Drivers picking up onion loads should call Fort Boise Produce before 3:00 PM the day prior to loading. ## TRUCK DRIVERS:

After loading, please proceed to the scale. If you want axle weights, call on CB Channel 16 and then start with your steer axle on the scale first. Proceed with the drive axles next and then the last weight will be the entire truck. After weighing, pull off of the scale and then come inside to the shipping office for your paperwork and a copy of your scale ticket. You will be allowed one free re-weigh.

Please keep additional axle weighings to a minimum. There are public scales one mile away if additional weighing is necessary.

Our scale is certified by the State of Idaho Bureau of Weights & Measures on an annual basis. A copy of the most recent certification may be viewed in the shipping office. Please note that while our scale is accurate there are NO GUARANTEES made as to Department of Transportation requirements for axle weight limitations, including fines. Please alert shipping personnel if you have bridge law restrictions or other limitations on your load. We will charge a reload fee if we are not informed ahead of time of any loading restrictions (bridge law, fixed axles, tandems, or 5<sup>th</sup> wheel) that you may require.

Please do not slide fifth wheel or tandems while on scale.

Traveling West on Interstate 84 in Idaho

Traveling East on Interstate 84 in Oregon

Traveling North from Winnemucca, NV on HWY 95

Traveling South from Lewiston, Idaho on HWY 95

Traveling East from Bend, Oregon on HWY 20

Traveling West on Interstate 84 in Idaho

Travel west on Interstate 84 and take Exit 3 south off the Interstate. Go left at the top of the off-ramp and travel south on to HWY 95 approximately 7 miles to Andersons Corner, which is at the junction of Highways 95 & 20/26. Turn right on HWY 20/26 towards Nyssa, Oregon. Fort Boise Produce is 1/2 mile on the left side of the highway.

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Traveling East on Interstate 84 in Oregon

Enter Idaho on Interstate 84 and take Exit 3 south off the Interstate. Go right at the top of the off-ramp and travel south on to HWY 95 approximately 7 miles to Andersons Corner, which is at the junction of Highways 95 & 20/26. Turn right on HWY 20/26 towards Nyssa, Oregon. Fort Boise Produce is 1/2 mile on the left side of the highway.

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Traveling North from Winnemucca, NV on HWY 95

Stay on HWY 95 northbound into Idaho. Travel north on 95 through Homedale and Wilder until you get to the junction of east/west Highway 20/26, just east of Parma, Idaho. Merge onto westbound 95/20/26. Travel west on 95/20/26 through Parma and follow the highway approximately 7 miles past Parma to Andersons Corner, which is at the junction of Highways 95 & 20/26. Turn left on HWY 20/26 towards Nyssa, Oregon. Fort Boise Produce is 1/2 mile on the left side of the highway.

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Traveling South from Lewiston, Idaho on HWY 95

Follow HWY 95 southbound through Grangeville and Weiser. Follow the spur of HWY 95, or truck route, through Payette and Fruitland. Pass over Interstate 84, staying on

HWY 95 south. Travel south on highway 95 approximately 7 miles to Andersons Corner, which is at the junction of Highways 95 & 20/26. Turn right on HWY 20/26 towards Nyssa, Oregon. Fort Boise Produce is 1/2 mile on the left side of the highway.

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Traveling East from Bend, Oregon on HWY 20

Stay on Hwy 20 through Burns, through Vale to the junction of HWY 201, approximately 12 miles past Vale. Take a right at the junction and travel south on HWY 201 approximately 7 miles to Nyssa. Proceed on Main Street through Nyssa, under the railroad tracks and across the Snake River into Idaho. Fort Boise Produce is located one mile into Idaho on the right side of the highway.

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
